Over Spring Break, Oral Health Exam information was sent home to Kindergarten students in need of an Oral Exam. Please make an appointment immediately to get your students checkup. Form is due to the office on May 31, 2013.



Students entering 7th grade

All students entering 7th grades will need proof of a Tdap booster shot before starting school. This requirement:

- Began July 1, 2011
- Can be met by receiving one dose of Tdap vaccine on or after the 10th birthday (the Tdap can be accepted if given on or after the 7th birthday, but the vaccine is generally not recommended this early)
- Can NOT be satisfied by a Td booster or having history of the disease
- Applies to both public and private schools.
